

Poppy Crochet Pattern

Abbreviations:

SL ST = Slip Stitch

CH = Chain

SC = Single Crochet

DC = Double Crochet

HDC = Half Double Crochet

TR = Treble Crochet

Notes:

- You can use any size hook or yarn type/ weight.
- Crochet is in US terms, not UK, so below is a conversion chart from pinterest

Crochet abbreviations conversions

Use this handy table to convert UK crochet terms to US crochet terms, or vice versa.

UK		US	
chain	ch	chain	ch
slip stitch	ss	slip stitch	ss
double crochet	dc	single crochet	sc
half treble	htr	half double	hdc
treble	tr	double	dc
double treble	dtr	treble	tr
triple treble	ttr	double treble	dtr

Centre of Poppy: (black/ brown wool)

- Make a magic ring and CH 3
- DC x 12 times, pull ring tight, SL ST to join, CH1 and tie off

Body of Poppy: (red wool)

- Start in any stitch and CH 3
- 3 TR in next stitch
- 3 TR in next 5 stitches (total of 6)
- CH 3, SL ST in next stitch
- CH 2
- 3 DC in next stitch
- 3 DC in next 4 stitches (total of 5)
- CH 2, SL ST in next stitch (last stitch remaining)
- CH 1 and tie off.

<u>Leaf (optional)</u>: (Green wool)

- Create slip knot and CH 7
- SL ST in 2nd CH from hook
- SC in next stitch
- HDC in next stitch
- DC in next 2 stitches
- 10 TR in last stitch of the chain
- DC in next 2 stitches
- HDC in next stitch
- SC in next stitch
- SL ST in top of leaf
- CH 1 and tie off
- Sew leaf on to Poppy body
